The Preservation Salvage Store is a nonprofit clearinghouse, converting donated and salvaged architectural building materials into charitable dollars.

While we are proud of the vast amount of materials we divert from landfill, we do possess a limited amount of storage space and must be strategic in what we can accept as material handling is our greatest challenge and largest expense. We are always available to answer more specific questions about our donation criteria at (504) 947-0038.

Doors

We accept: solid wood doors, interior and exterior, and solid doors with glass panels.

We do not accept: hollow core/slab doors, sliding glass patio doors, metal garage doors, bifold, or aluminum screen doors. Doors that are warped, rotted, or have major splits beyond simple repair cannot be taken.

Windows

We accept: wooden windows with complete trim and unbroken glass, and oversized window sashes with unbroken glass.

We do not accept: louvered, metal, or vinyl clad windows or metal window screens.

Lumber/Flooring

We accept: all dimensional lumber and tongue and groove flooring that is 6 feet minimum length and de-nailed

We do not accept: lumber or flooring less than 6 feet in length or that still contains nails or tacks. Bowed, knotted, or warped lumber is not accepted.

Shutters

We accept: wooden and louvered shutters as well as Creole cottage shutters

We do not accept: modern, vinyl or plastic shutters

Cabinets

We accept: vintage and modern base and wall mounts cabinets. Vintage metal cabinets need to be free of excessive rust.

We do not accept: cabinets with missing doors/drawers, cabinets with water damage, peeling laminate or press board

Sinks

We accept: vintage sinks or like-new modern sinks with pedestal or wall mounts.

We do not accept: cultured marble sinks or sinks with excessive rust or broken porcelain/marble

Tubs

We accept: clawfoot or like-new only

We do not accept: plastic tubs or tubs with excessive damage to the cast iron

Iron Work

We accept: all iron work within reason and capacity;

We do not accept: rolls of chain link fencing

Pick-Up Policy

Our store's stock is varied and plentiful and we accept many more items than what is listed above. Due to limited manpower, all donors are encouraged to make arrangements to drop-off their items at the Preservation Salvage Store during store hours. We are located at 2801 Marais Street, lakeside of St. Claude, between Franklin Ave. and the Press St. railroad tracks. Oversized donations that fit our guidelines can be scheduled for pick up by our staff. Please note that donation pickups outside of Orleans Parish will have a \$35 fee, payable by cash or check only.
